

ORDINANCE 2024-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DGL CONSULTING ENGINEERS FOR THE FUL-CR1-5.12 HALLETT AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS PHASE A PROJECT INSPECTOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an agreement with DGL Consulting Engineers for the purpose of needing a CA&I as required by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the FUL-CR1-5.12 Hallett Avenue Phase A Project.

Section Two. That \$117,110.00 proved to be the lowest and best proposal and is hereby figured into the cost of the construction through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).

Section Three. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Four. That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton; and the need to accept most qualified CA&I for this project in compliance with Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) requirements for the acceptance of funds. Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
