

Resolution 2024-37

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LUCAS COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS natural, technological, and man-made hazards can affect Village of Swanton; and

WHEREAS significant structural, historical, and economic losses could result from an occurrence of a natural, technological, or man-made hazard events; and

WHEREAS undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses Swanton incurs because of said hazard occurrences.

AND WHEREAS the Swanton Village Council has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS the hazard mitigation plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding, and, by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five years; and

WHEREAS a cooperative, joint effort is a proven, efficient way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Lucas County, Ohio.

THEREFORE the Swanton Village Council has partnered with the county to update the existing *Lucas County Countywide All Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan* in an effort to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the Village as well as to continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Council of the Village of Swanton adopts the updated Lucas County 2024 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan

Section Two. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three: This resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
